The SM400i is a 4", coaxial, ported speaker with a low-profile surface-mount enclosure design for indoor/outdoor applications that delivers a consistent dispersion pattern (2-10 kHz, independently verified). Mounting hardware is included and features a corrosion and theft-resistant Stealth[™] U-bracket for easy and secure installation. Nearly invisible from sight-lines, the Stealth U-bracket includes one way fasteners for tool-free theft-resistant security.

SoundTube's custom-engineered driver and electroacoustic network deliver high-performance sound in a cost-effective, surface-mount speaker design. The SM400i speaker incorporates a five-position tap switch with transformer bypass position for simplified ordering and stocking. Included port plugs can be used for added weather resistance.

Independent Data Acquisition and Verification

All data for SoundTube speakers is independently collected from and verified by NWAA Labs (www.nwaalabs.com) using their proprietary MACH testing system. All data is collected and analyzed according to ASTM, ISO and AES standards using EASERA, TEF and MLSSA. Full balloon data including both phase and magnitude is compiled into a variety of formats including EASE 4.x, GLL and CLF.

Architectural Specifications

The loudspeaker shall consist of a 102 mm (4") polypropylene woofer and one 25.4 mm (1") convex titanium tweeter with FerroFluid cooling.

Performance specifications of a typical production unit shall be as follows: Usable frequency response shall extend to 76 Hz (\pm 10 dB, full space, independently verified). Measured sensitivity (2.83 V input, 1 M) shall be at least 85.5 dB. The speaker shall have a nominal impedance of 4 Ω and be available for 25, 70.7, and 100 V modes and transformer bypass. The frequency dividing network shall have a crossover frequency of 2.27 kHz with slopes of 12 dB per octave (2nd order) for both low and high pass filters. Rated power capacity shall be at least 20 W continuous (RMS) and conform to EIA-426-B testing. Maximum continuous output at 1 M shall be 95.5 dB.

The low-frequency transducer shall have a polypropylene cone with butyl rubber surround. The high-frequency transducer shall be constructed of titanium with a proprietary BroadBeam waveguide.

Installation and safety attachment for the speaker shall be by Stealth U-bracket affixed to the speaker chassis via ABS handle with steel insert and shall include a safety cable for safety redundancy. The external wiring input connector shall be a four-pin, 5.08 mm Euroblock for 4 Ω or distributed systems and shall accept from 10 - 22-gauge wire. The system shall be for indoor and outdoor applications and shall have a weather-resistant terminal boot covering all wire connectors.

The enclosure shall be constructed of injection-molded ABS with optional port plug for added weather resistance. The plugs shall be constructed of closed-cell foam. The grille shall be constructed of powder-coated aluminum for lasting performance in the elements. The unit shall include mounting hardware, Euroblock connector and weather-resistant terminal boot. The maximum overall cabinet dimensions shall be 177 mm (6.97") in height by 245.9 mm (9.68") in width by 190 mm (7.47") in depth (including Stealth bracket).

The system shall be the SoundTube SM400i with mounting hardware for both low and high impedance applications.






